Topic: The darkness is thriving – Part 9

Bible Reading: Genesis 1:1-8

Jesus Christ set the captives free

Jesus Christ the Light came into this world to set the captives free. The mission of the Savior is to liberate the people who are in spiritual bondage of the darkness. The Messiah came to give independence to those who are under the influence and oppression of the darkness. The mission of Christ is to redeem mankind, and deliver those who are at the point of death. Christ came to save the people who are imprisoned spiritually by the darkness, thereby making it difficult to fulfill their missions and destinies on earth.

Isaiah prophesied about the mission of Jesus Christ on earth, and the prophecy was fulfilled when Jesus began His Galilean Ministry after John the Baptist His forerunner was imprisoned. Christ made His Light shine on the people living under the shadows of death. Those who sat enveloped in darkness, the Savior gave them light. Are you living in a region overshadowed by death? Do you know that Christ alone can give Light to those residing in dark land? Do you know that people living in dark Nations and crime-infected locations throughout the world need the Light of Christ?
