Topic: Do not get tired of doing good - Part 1

Bible Reading: Galatians 6:6-10

Introduction

Good is something that is virtuous and morally excellent. Good can be described as things to be desired and approved by any sane person. Anything that is admirable and right is good. Everything that is beneficial physically and spiritually to humanity is good. Therefore, anything that is right and has qualities for your spiritual growth is good, and it is acceptable to the Lord. Hence, do not be weary of doing whatever that is good and right.

Do good to silence the ignorant

It is the intention of God that by doing what is right, you will gag the ill-informed criticisms of the foolish people. It is the will of God to use your good and honest life to muzzle and nullify the ignorant charges brought against you. The Lord wants to use your doing right to silence stupid and ignorant people. The desire of your Maker is to use the good things you do to cure the ignorance of the fools who think you are a danger to society.

The Bible attested to this fact by saying; "For this is the will of God, that by doing good you may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men." <u>1 Peter 2:15.</u> Remember that it is your honorable life that God will use to silence the ignorant people who are making foolish accusations against you. By doing what is right and good, God will stop foolish people from saying stupid things about you.

<u>The loveless people:</u> Anyone who has adequate resources in this world and sees brethren in need, but has no compassion for them is a loveless person. The love of God is not residing in whoever has material possessions and sees brothers or sisters in need; but refuses to help. You cannot confess to love God if you fail to pity the poor people. You cannot claim to love God if you are rich and see others in need, but close your heart against them.

You do not love God, if you see the less privileged and have the means to do something about it; but turn a cold shoulder and do nothing; according to the scripture which says, "But whoever has this world's goods, and sees his brother in need, and shuts up his heart from him, how does the love of God abide in him?" 1 John 3:17. You must pity and assist others in order to prove that the love of God is abiding in your life.

You need to continue doing what is right without relenting to prove that you are obedient to your Maker. You must not grow tired of doing good if you want your Creator to be pleased with you. If you do not get discouraged in doing what is right; it means the love of God is residing in you, and you love others like yourself.

Do you belong to God?

The people who are practicing good and exhibiting godly character belong to God; while those who practice and tolerate evil belong to Lucifer; such people have no personal experience with their Creator. The only way to have intimacy with your Maker is to show moral courage and personal integrity. If you are from God, and His Spirit is dwelling in your life; you will follow the example of people who do right things and kind deeds. Inasmuch as God cannot condone evil, and evil cannot cohabit with the Lord; you must not get tired of doing good, if you want your cry for assistance to come to His presence.

For this reason, do not let bad examples influence you, but follow what is good; because those who do what is right prove that they are God's children, and people who continue in evil prove that they do not know God. Therefore, it is your duty to imitate your heavenly Father by doing good continuously. The Bible corroborated this fact by saying, "Beloved, do not imitate what is evil, but what is good. He who does good is of God, but he who does evil has not seen God." 3 John 1:11. You must do what is right and good to prove that you belong to God and you are doing His work. Doing good and what is right consistently is a way to demonstrate that you are a child of God.

Today, the world is inverted, and humans think they are wiser than their Maker; to the extent that the majority of people are worshipping the Lord with their lips, and their hearts are far from Him. People are praising God with songs, and honoring Him with words; whereas contrary things reside in their hearts. Nowadays, lip service is what is rampant among the Christendom; because Satan has deceived them, and he has put a spiritual veil to cover the faces of the Beloved.

The Book of Matthew confirmed this fact by saying, "These people draw near to Me with their mouth, and honor Me with their lips, but their heart is far from Me."

Matthew 15:8. Remember that you can deceive humans, but you cannot deceive God; therefore, worship God in truth and Spirit. Do not cease doing good; in order to be admitted into the Glorious Home. You must not imitate what is evil, but model the good; so that you will be acceptable in the presence of the

Lord. Beware not to follow the steps of the people in the world who are doing whatever that is right in their eyes.

Nowadays, everyone is doing whatever seems right to them. People in the 'nooks and crannies' throughout the world are acting according to their opinion and not according to the instructions of the Lord. You must not do things that seem right to you, but displease God. Inasmuch as the wisdom of this world is foolishness with God; therefore, do not go along with evil, but follow what is good.

Topic: Do not get tired of doing good – Part 2

Bible Reading: Galatians 6:6-10

Turning from good is a sin

Today, the majority of the people in the world are heartless, and they are not doing what is right. The cruel people are doing terrible things, instead of doing good. Numerous twisted people in the world are calling abnormal and distorted things good. Lack of knowledge is making humanity call what is wrong right and substituting evil for good. The so-called civilization is making mankind to discard the commandments of the Lord at an alarming rate.

The mentality of many people in the world is abnormal, and they are behaving in shameless ways. Therefore, do not live according to the dictates of your heart, or act like the unbelievers. You need to cease doing things the way the ungodly people are doing them; instead, do things the right way, so that you will be rewarded by your Maker. Do not allow your desires to make you turn from doing good and sin against the Lord.

For this reason, you must keep the rules and regulations of the Lord; because whoever obeys them will live. It is simple: keep the statutes of the Lord, and you will be saved. You must not get tired of doing good; if you want eternal life. Are you ready to obey the laws of the Lord and live by His decrees; in order to have a prolonged life? The Bible confirmed this fact by saying, "You shall therefore keep My statutes and My judgments, which if a man does, he shall live by them: I am the Lord." Leviticus 18:5. Do not forget that if you obey the commands of God, you will find life through them.

Hence, do not turn away from what is right; so that it shall be well with you. Anyone who turns from doing good and engaging in doing detestable things will be penalized. You must not get tired of doing good; if you do not want all your good deeds to be forgotten. Falling into sin means stop doing good, and there will be consequences.

Whoever cease doing good will start doing evil, and there will be repercussions; according to the scripture which says, "But when a righteous man turns away from his righteousness and commits iniquity, and does according to all the abominations that the wicked man does, shall he live? All the righteousness which he has done shall not be remembered; because of the unfaithfulness of which he is guilty and the sin which he has committed, because of them he shall die." **Ezekiel** 18:24. Do not be weary of doing good; if you do not want all your righteous acts to be forgotten.

Do good to all people

It is the duty of the Believers to do good to all people. If you do not do what you know is right, you have sinned against God. You have committed an offense when you know the right thing to do, but refuse to do it. If you fail to do the good you know you should do; then, you are guilty of sin. Remember, it is sin to know what you ought to do and not do it. The Bible attested to this fact by saying, "Therefore, to him who knows to do good and does not do it, to him it is sin." <u>James 4:17.</u> If you know what is right and fail to do it; your failure will be counted as sin.

Anytime you favor those who favors you, what credit is that to you? It is not commendable, if you are kind to those who are kind to you alone. The way to be a legal child of your heavenly Father is to be good to all people, and not only those who are good to you. It is not wonderful, when you help only the people who helped you; according to the Book of Luke which says, "And if you do good to those who do good to you, what credit is that to you? For even sinners do the same." <u>Luke 6:33.</u> You do not deserve any thanks, when you benefit only those who benefit you; because you are only reciprocating their good gesture.

You have the chance now as a living soul to do good to all people, not only being helpful; but also doing what is for their spiritual good and advantage. It is necessary for you to help people whenever you can; especially, if they are followers of the Lord. It is important for you to work for the good of all whenever you have an opportunity, and particularly for those in the household of faith. Be kind to everyone, and mostly to our Christian brothers and sisters.

It is time for you to work for the benefit of all, starting with the people closest to you in the community of faith; according to the Bible passage which says, "Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all, especially to those who are of the household of faith." **Galatians 6:10.** Be mindful to be a blessing, especially to those who belong to God's family.

You need to imitate Jesus Christ who went around doing good, and healing people who are under the power of the devil. Jesus Christ laid the example; he went everywhere doing good and healing everyone oppressed by the darkness. The Bible corroborated this fact by saying, "How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him." **Acts 10:38.**

Topic: Do not get tired of doing good – Part 3

Bible Reading: Galatians 6:6-10

Do good to benefit your descendants

The word of Almighty God is right, and all His acts are done in good faith; even if humans cannot comprehend them. The Lord is truthful, and He can be trusted to act in the best interest to preserve His creatures. It is important to note that the messages of the Lord are true, and all His works are dependable. If everything that God does is right; don't you think you too should continue doing what is right without getting weary?

Don't you think it is time for you to imitate God by not getting tired of doing good? If you are upright, don't you think you have to proclaim that the decrees of God are just and fair? If you are a child of God, don't you think you must be fair in all your dealings? The Bible attested to this fact by saying, "For the word of the Lord is right, and all His work is done in truth." Psalm 33:4. If you are truly a Beloved, you will not get weary of doing what is right.

For this reason, be watchful and obey all these words that you heard today; so that it may go well with you and your children forever; when you do what is good and right in the sight of God. Obey and pay attention to everything written in this publication; so that you and your descendants will prosper physically and spiritually. If you pay attention to this sermon; you will be doing what God says is right and good; then, God will assist you and your descendants to be successful.

As it is written, "Observe and obey all these words which I command you, that it may go well with you and your children after you forever, when you do what is good and right in the sight of the Lord your God." **Deuteronomy 12:28.** Do not forget to be vigilant, and obey instructions of the Lord; so that it shall be well with you and your descendants forever. Whenever you do things that are virtuous in the sight of the Lord; your name will be written in the Book of Remembrance.

Hence, do what is right and good in the sight of the Lord; so that you may prosper. If you live in a way that pleases God, He will make you inherit the

promises made to your ancestors. One of the ways to make the promises of God to be fulfilled in your life is to do what is right and good; according to the scripture which says, "And you shall do what is right and good in the sight of the Lord, that it may be well with you, and that you may go in and possess the good land of which the Lord swore to your fathers."

Deuteronomy 6:18. Do not provoke God, but obey Him; so that His promises will be fulfilled in your life. The master key that opens the spiritual door of success and prosperity is doing what is right and good.

<u>Pay no attention to insults:</u> Pay attention to the word of God, you who know righteousness and are in right standing with God; do not fear the taunting of men, or be distressed at their reviling. Listen to me, you who meditate on the instructions of the Lord; do not fear human scorn, and do not be upset when they abuse you for doing good. Anyone who wants to do right and obey the teaching of the Lord with his/her heart, must not be discouraged when others insult such a person, and say hurtful things.

If you cherish the laws of God in your heart; you will not be afraid of people's contempt, or their slanderous talk, because it is a distraction; according to the Book of Isaiah which says, "Listen to Me, you who know righteousness, you people in whose heart is My law: Do not fear the reproach of men, nor be afraid of their insults." **Isaiah 51:7.** If the teaching of the Holy Bible is fixed in your heart; you will not be upset when people taunt you, or be discouraged by their ridicule.

You are very fortunate, and you will be rewarded for what you have done; if you are not tired of doing good. It shall be well with you, and you will eat the fruit of your deeds; if you are not weary of doing right. You are blessed, and you will consume the product of your labor; if you continuously do right and good. We are reassuring the godly people that their good living will pay off, and they will receive the reward of their acts/deeds; according to the Book of Isaiah which says, "Say to the righteous that it shall be well with them, for they shall eat the fruit of their doings." Isaiah 3:10.
Remember, those who do right and good persistently will be blessed, and they will enjoy the rich reward they have earned.

<u>Turn your back on evil:</u> Every soul who intends to inherit the kingdom of heaven must turn his/her back on a sinful lifestyle; such a person must

start doing what is right and good. You need to do good instead of evil, and try to live at peace with everybody if you want to please God. Turning away from evil, start doing good and embracing peace, is a criterion to be acceptable to God. If you forsake all immoral acts and wrongdoings; by spending your time doing right and good; then you are heaven bound. The Bible attested to this fact by saying, "Depart from evil and do good; Seek peace and pursue it." **Psalm 34:14.** You must turn away from what is lustful and start doing what is good for God to be delighted in you.

It is the instructions of the Lord to depart from evil and do good; in order to live securely anywhere on earth. If you stop sinning and start doing right, you will keep living and be secure forever. If you want to be admitted into the Eternal Home, leave your evil, low-down ways and live a good life before God. For the heavens to recognize you; turn your back on evil, work for good continuously and do not quit; according to the Bible passage which says, "Depart from evil, and do good; And dwell forevermore."

Psalm 37:27. Turn away from nefarious activities, do what is right and you will enjoy lasting security. It is simple; avoid evil, do good, and live forever.

Topic: Do not get tired of doing good – Part 4

Bible Reading: Galatians 6:6-10

God prefers justice to sacrifices

There is nothing better for humans than to be glad, and do justice as long as they live. It is more excellent for people to be happy, and enjoy themselves moderately during their lifetime. The best things that mankind can do during their existence are to obey the instructions of their Maker and enjoy life. There is nothing better than assisting others, have a good time, and get the most you can out of life.

The Book of Ecclesiastes clarifies this directive of the Lord, by saying; "I know that nothing *is* better for them than to rejoice, and to do good in their lives." **Ecclesiastes 3:12.** Though, the best thing is for you to be cheerful and enjoy what is good in your life; however, do not forget to do right and assist others. Rejoice and do the best you can while you are still alive, but do things calmly and moderately.

Today, the foundations of a godly society are being attacked on a daily basis. Corruption and nefarious activities are derailing the faith of many people. Christendom is in a spiritual slumber that is making the forces of darkness to sneak into the Churches, and causing mayhem in the vineyard of the Lord across the globe. The way things are going when the bottom of things falls out, what can the righteous accomplish? What can an honest person do when everything crumbles?

The foundations of law and order are collapsing at an alarming rate, as a Believer, will you standby and do nothing? Are you going to stay idle when the foundations of Christianity are caving in? The Book of Psalms affirmed this fact by saying, "If the foundations are destroyed, what can the righteous do? **Psalm 11:3.** Do not succumb to the wiles of Satan. The godly people must join forces, and collaborate to rectify the situation. Anyone who calls himself/herself a Beloved must put in his/her best; so that everything will not fall apart.

Hence, people need to realize that justice is more acceptable to the Lord than sacrifice for wrongs repeatedly committed. Doing what is right and

fair, pleases the Lord more than an offering. The Lord values virtue and justice more than sacrifices. Clean living before God and fairness with your neighbors is more important to the Lord than offerings, or donations.

The Bible attested to this fact by saying, "To do righteousness and justice is more acceptable to the Lord than sacrifice." **Proverbs 21:3.** Do not forget that God prefers doing what is right and just than sacrifices. Therefore, it is better to do the good that God desires than making donations to the Churches. Inasmuch as you cannot deceive, or bribe God; do what is right; rather than trying to pacify Him with offerings.

Topic: Do not get tired of doing good – Part 5

Bible Reading: Galatians 6:6-10

You will reap what you sow

Do not be deceived, God will not allow Himself to be ridiculed, or treated with contempt; because whatever anyone sows is what he/she will reap. Make no mistake, God is not mocked, a person will harvest what he/she plants. Do not be fooled; you cannot cheat God. People harvest only what they plant. Whether you like it or not, either you believe it or not; you will reap whatever you sow whether good or bad.

No one makes a fool of God; so, do not be misled, because you cannot ignore the instructions of the Lord and get away with it. Therefore, sow right and good; in order to reap longevity and prosperity. The Book of Galatians corroborated this fact by saying, "Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap." **Galatians 6:7.** Inasmuch as you cannot fool God, stop making a fool of yourself by starting to do what is right, and good.

For this reason, do not lose courage on the day of distress; else your strength is minimal. Do not give up, or become helpless in times of trouble; but continue to be nice to others. Anyone who is slack or careless in a difficult time; instead of being kind to others is weak. If you fall to pieces in a crisis; instead of standing firm, and have compassion on others; it is a weakness. If you cannot stand the pressure of adversity, then your strength is limited; according to the Bible passage which says, "If you faint in the day of adversity, your strength is small. Proverbs 24:10. If you fail under pressure; instead of assisting others; your power is small. Therefore, do not falter in a time of trouble, but continue to do good and right.

Do not lose heart: You must not lose heart, or grow weary doing what is right and good; because at the appointed season, you will reap the rewards of your deeds; if you do not loosen, and relax. It is important to know that at the proper time, you will reap what you have sown whether good or bad; if you do not give in. You must not be discouraged, if you desire to be rewarded. If you do not give up, or get tired of helping others; you will be recompensed by the Lord when the time is right.

Anyone who does not get tired of doing right and good, will receive the harvest of eternal life at the right time; according to the Bible passage which says,

"And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart." **Galatians 6:9.** If you are not exhausted from doing good, you will be recompensed; if you do not grow weary. You will reap a harvest of blessings; if you do not get discouraged and give up.

Therefore, be assured that you will be rewarded for any good thing you do; immaterial of your race, gender, and color. God will never fail to recompense every person who does what is right; regardless of the nationality of such a person. It is certain that the Lord will reward every Christian during their lifetime for the good work they do. The Bible confirmed this fact by saying, "Knowing that whatever good anyone does, he will receive the same from the Lord, whether *he is* a slave or free." **Ephesians 6:8.** Remember that the Lord will give a reward to everyone; whether master, or messenger for doing good; so, do not cease doing right.

Topic: Do not get tired of doing good - Part 6

Bible Reading: Galatians 6:6-10

God will not justify the wicked

Our Lord God is fair and just in all His ways, and righteousness is His priority. So, keep far away from false matters; because God will not justify the wicked. Do not bring false charges against anyone, and stay away from fraud; because God will not acquit any guilty person; immaterial of the person's financial, educational, and celebrity background. Inasmuch as God abhors the wicked; you must not accuse anyone falsely, or twist judgment to punish the innocent people.

Avoid telling lies, and do not make false accusations; because God cannot be deceived or influenced; instead, He will condemn the people who are doing such evil things. It is important for you not to contribute to the punishment, or suffering of the innocent people; because God will not let you off the hook. Depart from every form of dishonesty, and do not manipulate charges to cause trauma for any blameless person; because you will be held accountable; according to the scripture which says, "Keep yourself far from a false matter; do not kill the innocent and righteous. For I will not justify the wicked." **Exodus 23:7.** Have nothing to do with a false charge or matter; because God will never declare a guilty person to be innocent or acquit the wicked.

Do no injustice: Humans must stop exhibiting inequity in all judgments. It is inevitable for you not to do injustice in judgment, if you want God to be delighted in you. Do not be partial to the less privileged or show preference for the wealthy people; instead, judge fairly; so that it shall be well with you throughout your lifetime. It is your duty not to act unjustly whenever you are deciding any case. Do not show favoritism to the poor, or deference to the distinguished people. Whatever the circumstance, be fair, no matter who is on trial; do not favor the poor or the rich.

Be honest and just whenever you are making decisions in every case. Serving justice, and not perverting judgment is one of the ways to please the Lord; according to the Bible passage which says, "You shall do no

injustice in judgment. You shall not be partial to the poor, nor honor the person of the mighty. In righteousness you shall judge your neighbor." **Leviticus 19:15.** Do not twist justice in any way, if you do not want to be guilty in the presence of God. Remember, anyone who favors the poor, or biased to the rich; does not belong to God.

Do not offer your body to sin: Do not offer parts of your body to sin, or be used as weapons to do wrong. Yielding your bodily members, or faculties to sin as tools of wickedness is an abomination before God. Therefore, offer all the parts of your body to God to be used as weapons to do right. Give yourself totally to God, and make every part of your body a slave that pleases the Lord. Do not surrender any part of yourself to sin, and be used for wicked purposes; instead, surrender your whole being to God to be used for righteous purposes. Any wise person will not give sin a vote in the way he/she conducts his/her life, and such a person will not run errands that are connected with his/her old sinful way of life.

It is time for you to cease using your body to commit atrocities that can make you end your journey in Satan's camp; instead, use your body to do everything that the Lord instructed. The Bible attested to this fact by saying, "And do not present your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God."

Romans 6:13. Stop using your body to serve sin, but start using your body to do what is right for the glory of God.

Focus on Christ to boost your endurance: Think of Jesus Christ who endured from sinners' grievous opposition and bitter hostility; yet He did not deny His heavenly Father. It is time for you to consider the events that happened to Jesus our Savior, and compare them to your trials; then you will realize that your own test of faith is tiny. If you ponder on many insults that Christ experienced; you will not be discouraged and you won't give up doing right and good; because of your own negligible troubles.

Anyone who is focused on Jesus Christ will not grow weary, or exhausted doing just and virtuous things. Whatever you are passing through, do not relax, or be tired of doing what is acceptable to the Lord. Whenever you are flagging in your faith, go over the story of Jesus Christ to boost your

faith; so that you will not relent following the directives of the Lord, or lose heart; because of your present situations. The Bible corroborated this fact by saying, "For consider Him who endured such hostility from sinners against Himself, lest you become weary and discouraged in your souls."

Hebrews 12:3. Inasmuch as your problems are incomparable to what Jesus Christ endured; do not stray from the righteous path, but continue to obey the instructions of the Lord by doing virtuous things.

<u>The Seal: 2 Thessalonians 3:13:</u> But as for you, brethren, do not grow weary in doing good.
